
INSECT



Insect body is divided into three parts:

- 1.Head
- 2.Thorax
- 3. Abdomen

Head

- The head contains the following structures:
- a) Compound eyes
- b) Simple eyes (Ocellus)
- c) Front
- d) Gena
- e) Clypeus
- f) Labrum

Thorax

• There are three regions in the thorax which are pro-thorax, meso-thorax and meta-thorax. They contain the following components:

- a) Wings: forewings and hind wings.
- b) Legs: walking legs and jumping legs.

Abdomen

• It is the hind part of insect which consists of many rectangular segments each one of them contains spiracles and the last segments have a modification to form the reproductive structures such as the ovipositors. In addition to the appendages called cercus (pleural cerci). These structure serve as sensory organ or as pinching weapons or as organ of copulation.
