Teaching Victorian and nineteenth century novel for the third year students. First of all, we start with an introduction to the era, describing, illuminating and illustrating all the elements of that era which helped making it different and boosted the development of the novel as an art or as a genre. Element like the gothic literature, romantic literature, style

Furthermore, the class starts giving information about the prominent figures of the period; like Charles Dickens, Emely Bronte, Charlotte Bronte, Jane Austen, Nathanial Hawthorn,....

Moreover, we start with the most prominent writer Charles Dickens tackling his life and works then we shift to his masterpiece Great Expectations. Then we move the American literature of that era choosing Nathanial Hawthorn and his novel The Scarlet Letter to be tackled in the second term. The students supposed to study Wuthering Heights as a homework assignment.
