- Mendeley Group: is a structure in which a group of researchers can collaborate and share their libraries or selective references of their libraries.
- The group can be created in your desktop mendeley or in web mendeley. Mendeley Web will also allow you to search, join, and follow groups.

Types of groups

- Open: An open group will allow anyone to contribute, become a member, or follow.
- Invite-Only: This group will allow you to share references, but not files, and can be viewed publicly.
- Private: Private groups allow you to share files and annotations between members.
 These groups are not visible to others outside the private group.

description >


select the group

type > create >


from members tab
