Morphology

Adult worm: cylindrical shape, creamy white or pinkish in color, the anterior being thinner than posterior end

Adult male: 15-30 cm in length, 3-4 mm in diameter, tail curved ventrally

Adult female; 20-40 cm length, 2-6mm diameter, tail straight and pointed

Morphology

The adult worm is small, cylindrical worm, greyish-white or pinkish in color. The mouth has teeth are found in the buccal capsule, Each of them has large that are fused at their bases.

Females are often long and stouter (10 mm to 13 mm long), with the vulva located at the posterior end; females can lay 10,000 to 30,000 eggs per day.

Males are 8 mm 11 mm small with a copulatory bursa at the posterior end and spicules



Copulatory bursa Its extension of cuticle on the posterior end of some species of male nematodes, its used to grasp the female during copulation
